Fire Recovery and Resilience Workforce Program

The Fire Recovery and Resilience Workforce Program provides paid disaster relief jobs, transitional employment, and job training to dislocated and impacted workers—while supporting long-term career mobility.

LABORERS AND CAREER SUPERVISORS

ELIGIBILITY & QUALIFICATIONS

1. Individuals must meet the eligibility and enrollment requirement for the program found at opportunity.lacounty.gov/FireWorkforce.
2. Individuals must be able to stand or walk long periods of time, with frequent bending, stooping, squatting, twisting, reaching, and working on irregular surfaces.
3. Individuals must also be able to occasionally lift objects weighing over 25 pounds and frequently lift objects weighing between 10 and 25 pounds.



LABORER JOB DUTIES \$25/HR WITH BENEFITS

- Pick up and dispose of debris on the beach, in beach parking lots, or impacted areas
- Remove debris and refill trash containers used for debris removal
- Assist with removal of animals that wash up on the beach
- Clean and restock restrooms used by first responders and other recovery related situations
- Assist with landscaping related to removal, replanting, or maintenance of disaster impacted plants, trees, shrubs, etc
- Drive to other locations as needed based on disaster related impacts

CREW SUPERVISOR DUTIES \$27/HR WITH BENEFITS

- In addition to Laborer duties:
- Provide instructions to assigned staff
 - Oversee work projects
 - Manage work assignments and schedule shifts
 - Onboard new staff and provide necessary duty related training
 - Assist staff with the duties when needed
 - Evaluate work performance and share feedback with staff and America's Job Center of California
