CHILDCARE WORKER DUTIES \$20/HR WITH BENEFITS

- Assists in developing, conducting, and promoting recreation programs, such as arts and crafts, nature education, theater arts, music, dance, sports, and holiday events for disaster impacted school age children.
- Assists in observing free play, team activities, group classes, craft exhibits, and ensures park safety rules are followed.
- Assists in ensuring a safe, clean park environment.
- Sets up recreation areas, gymnasiums and playing fields for scheduled events.
- Performs various routine clerical duties related to park operations, recreational programs, and inventory of equipment/supplies.
- Performs basic housekeeping tasks such as putting supplies away, wiping down furniture and equipment.
- Monitors and closing of park facilities and amenities as needed.
