- **Prep Cook Pre-Apprenticeship** – Learn kitchen safety, knife skills, food handling, and more to prepare for hotel and food service jobs.
- **Line Cook Apprenticeship** – Advance your culinary skills with hands-on instruction and earn an industry-recognized certificate and U.S. Department of Labor certification.
- **Barista Apprenticeship** – Gain hands-on barista and customer service skills while earning certifications in food safety and specialty coffee preparation.
