CONSTRUCTION WORKER DUTIES \$20-\$27/HR

- Dig trenches by hand (shoveling, grading, cleaning trench bottoms).
- Help lay pipe (water, sewer, storm, conduit).
- Carry and stage materials (pipe, fittings, tools).
- Set up and tear down traffic control.
- Assist with connecting pipes and sealing joints.
- Backfill trenches and compact soil.
- Spot equipment operators (guide them safely).
- Keep the job site clean and organized.
