#### CONSTRUCTION WORKER DUTIES \$20-\$27/HR

- Assist skilled trades such as carpenters, electricians, plumbers, and foremen.
- Load, unload, and transport materials, tools, and equipment.
- Prepare and clean construction sites, including removing debris and hazardous materials.
- Operate basic hand and power tools in a safe manner.
- Perform general labor tasks such as digging, lifting, carrying, mixing materials, and demolition.
